# Life Matters

Dear Friends For Life,

Here is one of my favorite math jokes: What did the eight, 8, say to infinity,  $\infty$ ? "Are you going to lay around forever?"

Many parts of mathematics only make sense if you fully understand their *meaning*. "Infinity", for instance. Infinity is a concept, not a "thing"; it is certainly not a number. (Hang in there – I am going somewhere with this :)

Students new to calculus where the term and symbol are used tend to think infinity IS a number, a location in the number system. They think -- hopefully only originally -- that this notation, " $x \rightarrow \infty$ " (read "the value of x approaches infinity"), means there is some distant value "x" is heading toward.

What it really means is that the x values involved are "increasing *without bound*", or infinitely (!) far; that there is no limit to the values. Ok, thanks Mike, for something I could care less about! Hang in there.

The word "forever" shows up 289 times in the NIV translation of the Bible. (The word infinity . . . ? None.) "Forever" – without end, no bound, no limit. One example came from the reading for this Sunday (2nd Sunday after Epiphany, January 18) in Psalm 40: 5.

**"Many, LORD my God, are the wonders you have done, the things you planned for us. None can compare with you; were I to speak and tell of your deeds, they would be *too many* to declare."**

That is, it is impossible to count all of His "deeds", there are infinitely many.

We are infinite beings. I don't just mean going to paradise and living forever there. We were planned from before time. Just like God tells Jeremiah:

**"Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart"** Jeremiah 1:5

Of course, we know well Psalm 139 and David's being "knit in the womb". But in verse 16 we read **"All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be."**

And Paul says **"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, even as he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him."** Galatians 1: 3 - 4 (see Ephesians 1:4) The Lord of Life, Yahweh, is a God of eternal love, a God who continually blesses without limit, *despite* how we "treat" Him, and those around us.

Every human person, from conception (*actually, before*) til "infinity" (!) is a valuable creation of the Most High God, a person loved by God, whose sins are paid for by the Lamb.

Every human person involved in wrongfully killing another person, is under God's powerful wrath. Only the everlasting love this same God offers can cleanse and forgive them – forever. It is His infinite plan for them.

God bless us as we bring this message to this sin-sick world; as we continually do what we can to educate and teach His will regarding LIFE; as we as "Gospel-motivated voices for life" bring the good news to the heathen world.

## 2026 POSTER CONTEST

Sponsored by Lutherans For Life of Missouri

**For students in Grades 3 through 5**

Any Lutheran student or student in a Lutheran school is eligible.

### Contest Guidelines

1. This poster contest is to celebrate all life that God has created, including the preborn, the disabled, and the elderly.
2. The poster should be based on a Bible passage, hymn verse, or Sunday School song.

The poster size should be 18" x 12".

3. Use creativity to express ideas with paint, markers, crayons, colored paper, fabric, etc.  
Anything goes as long as the poster can be hung.
4. Use a method (paint, marker [*no pencil*], stick-on letters, etc.) to print any words on the front. Pen should be used to fill out the student information sheet. (This will make it easier for the judges to see the digital submission and make the poster more artistically appealing to the viewer.)
5. A school may submit their winning poster digitally along with the **Student Information Form** via email to: [dalbers.102@gmail.com](mailto:dalbers.102@gmail.com) by March 1, 2026.
6. There will be a First Place Award of \$50 and a Second Place Award of \$25, which will be awarded at LFL of MO's Annual Meeting.  
Mentors of the two winners will also receive an award equal to their student's award.
7. All entries become the property of LFL of MO and the actual First and Second place winning posters will be used for display by LFL of MO at various conferences throughout the year.

## **Judging will be based on:**

1. The focus should be on Life.
2. The poster must be based on a Bible verse, hymn, or Sunday School song verse, which may not necessarily be displayed on the poster. (Words or phrases may be chosen for the poster and the whole of the Bible verse, hymn, or song may be printed on the Student Information Form.) The Bible verse, etc. must be visually brought to Life! Use a method (paint, marker, stick-on letters, etc.) to print any words so that they can easily be read. No pencil, please!
3. Materials are used well to express the idea and theme of the poster.
4. Neatness and correct spelling of any words used.

# Lutherans For Life

## 2026 Missouri Essay Contest

Sponsored by the LFL Council of Federation Presidents

For Students in Grades 6–8 and 9–12

Any student in a Lutheran school or Lutheran congregation (e.g., confirmation class, youth group, Lutheran home school) is eligible when validated by their teacher or pastor, along with parental consent.

### Contest Guidelines

Students will write a life-affirming essay based on the theme “That They May Have Life” using John 10:10, “The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.”

1. Examples of topics the essay could deal with are – but are not limited to – abortion, disabilities, adoption, foster care, infanticide, physician-assisted suicide, hospice care, sexual purity, etc. For more information on life topics, see [lutheransforlife.org](http://lutheransforlife.org).
2. The first page of the essay must include the student’s name, grade, school or church, a personal mailing address, email address, and phone number (of the student or parent).
3. All entries must be submitted by a teacher or pastor and include their contact information.
4. Grades 6–8 should submit essays up to 400 words. The word count does not include the title, footnotes, or bibliography.
5. Grades 9–12 should submit essays up to 750 words. The word count does not include the title, footnotes, or bibliography.
6. Entries must be submitted digitally using Microsoft Word or Google Docs (PDF files or other formats will not be accepted). Email your entry to Diane Albers at [dalbers.102@gmail.com](mailto:dalbers.102@gmail.com) by March 15, 2026.
7. The omission of any of the following required items will cause disqualification of the essay:
  - a. \*\* The essay must include the entire theme and the entire theme Bible verse as part of the written text.
  - b. Each essay must include a title. Using the required theme as a title is acceptable but does not replace using the theme and verse within the essay.
  - c. The essay must be in complete agreement with the Lutherans For Life mission to “Equip Lutherans and their neighbors to be Gospel-motivated voices For Life”.
  - d. A Bibliography listing sources used is required.
  - e. Limiting to the appropriate word count.
8. Essays should make good use of standard essay writing components, including introduction and conclusion, main points, organization, style, mechanics, sources, and bibliography (See page 2 for directions on using these elements).
9. There will be a \$200 first-place award and a \$100 second-place award for each of the two grade levels. The two first place grade level winners will advance to the national contest.
10. The national award for the winning entry in each category is \$500 for first place, plus free conference registration to the 2026 Lutherans For Life conference for the student and his/her parents, one-night stay at the conference hotel for the student and his/her parents, \$200 travel expense reserved for conference travel only, and a framed certificate. The second-place award is \$250 and a framed certificate.
11. All entries, including exclusive copyrights, become the property of Lutherans For Life.

***Applicants for one of the \$1000 awards should meet the following criteria:***

- Member of the 2026 Senior Class of a High School (Lutheran, Public or Homeschool) in Missouri;
- Member of a Lutheran Church;
- Recommended by a Pastor, Principal or Lutheran Pro-Life Organization Sponsor;
- Commitment to “pro-life” Activities; Such life affirming activities may include visiting nursing home residents, volunteering at a homeless shelter, assisting with Life Sunday events, Pro-Life walks, diaper drives, being an active member of a student Life group, or any other activities that advocate the sanctity of and respect for all human life.
- Complete the Award Application.

## What does your LFL of MO board do?



As you have already read, we are promoting Life by **assisting LHS students** who wish to attend Y4Life in DC. We are asking our fellow MO Lifers to help.

Along with helping those young people, we annually sponsor:

the 3 -5 grade **poster contest**, where the winner and mentor receive \$50, with \$25 for the second place winner and their mentor;

the 6 - 8 and 9 – 12 grade **essay contests**, where each contest winner and mentor receive \$200, with \$100 for the second place winner and mentor of each contest;

and the Leonard Wallenmeyer **Life Award**, where the two high school Lutheran senior applicants chosen to receive it each receive a \$1000 award.

Educators of our young people are notified of these through the MO District communications, as well as through our newsletter. Congregations without schools will also be informed by the District. You can also tell Lutheran students that you know of.

The Lutheran High School principals of our MO schools are notified of the High School opportunities by email. Also, any Life leaders of the schools that I have contact for are notified.

Our young people are our future Life leaders. This is all possible because of your generous giving.

We created the **Adoption Fund**, working with Lifesong. Families desiring to adopt a child are offered financial help as they proceed in their attempt. We need your help to continue building up this fund and to spread the word about this opportunity in your congregation.

Donations can be sent to John Mueller (see above) with the memo “Adoption Fund”.

We host the annual **Missouri’s Largest Diaper Drive**. Each site where the donated diapers are taken is reported to us. That site also receives a \$50 check in honor of the group that collected the diapers.

Whenever there is a conference in MO you will find members of the board **displaying information** for the attendees. This includes LFL produced handouts, handouts regarding the contests and award mentioned above, opportunities to join LFL of MO. We are there also to answer questions that arise.

In 2025 this included the March on the Arch, the Midwest March, the Missouri District Convention and the Missouri Pastor’s Conference.

The board **meets quarterly** to discuss how we can best use the resources you provide. We also discuss how we can best promote Lutherans For Life, particularly in Missouri.

A **newsletter** is produced every quarter and mailed to our constituents. We have saved a lot of money by offering these by email. Thanks to those of you who are willing to do this. The newsletter is also placed on our website [lflfmo.org](http://lflfmo.org), along with other useful information.

Other pertinent Life information is sent out using the email list. When Amendment 3 was up for vote, I was able to send a lot of information about it. NOW, a **new Amendment 3** is on the way – it will replace the previously passed one, restoring the original life-affirming legislation that was stripped away.

We hold an annual meeting in the spring, the **Missouri Life Summit**. Speakers and presenters lead us in understanding certain Life topics. At that time there is a brief meeting. A report is given on the activities of LFL of MO for the past year. This is also when elections are held for board positions.

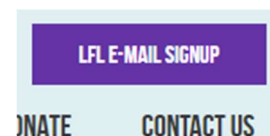

## Chapter and Life Team Reports

**Christ Memorial, St. Louis LT** We sponsored another Monarch Jewelry event on November 20. These events have always been very successful, raising money for Crisis Aid International, specifically for the St. Louis area. The funds are used to assist those who have been trafficked. We will host another one in May. Continuous collection of baby items takes place for the Pregnancy Help Center, Nurses for Newborns, and Swaddling Clothes, and of used jewelry for Monarch. A table was presented for Life Weekend – all “babies” in a blanket were taken by children. Diane led the children’s message. We again are hosting the Baby Bottle campaign to raise funds for the Pregnancy Help Center.

**MO Valley Chapter** We hosted a Life Sunday dinner on Jan. 18. Rev. Dr. Robert Weise was a guest speaker. The group had a booth at the Pecan Festival in Brunswick, Mo. in October. This has been done for a number of years. We continue to support Carrollton, Mo. Birthright. The group has provided more than \$1000 worth of diapers for distribution through Birthright.

**Rolla Area Life Chapter** We most recently observed Life Sunday in various ways. Immanuel Rolla’s Life Team provided refreshments for the Sunday morning Bible class and provided pro-life materials for church service attendees. The Immanuel LWML Dorcas Society has teamed with the Life Team to request Thrivent Action Team Grants. These grants purchased diapers, wipes and formula packaged in handmade tote bags for the Rolla Pregnancy Resource Center. Often, handmade crib quilts or blankets are included in the tote bags. They also make lap robes for hospital infusion patients and nursing home residents. We are gearing up to host the Life Summit on April 25.

**Springfield Life Chapter** We had a most amazing Christmas party for a local nursing home. Eighteen members were on hand to pass out personalized gifts for the residents, carol, even tap dance, and most importantly major snacks!! It was hard to decide who enjoyed themselves more – the hosts or the guests! We are already planning a Happy Spring party for March. These precious elderly people are close to our hearts as we celebrate the dear gift of life. *God is able to provide you with every blessing in abundance, so that by always having enough of everything you may share abundantly in every good work. 2 Corinthians 9:8*

**Trinity LT, Columbia** Our Life team meets monthly. We enjoy a light supper together with fellowship and discussion prior to our official meeting. We continue to minister to our home bound members with quarterly Goodie bags, monthly cards, visits, and calls. We celebrated Life Sunday January 11 and January 18th. We were pleased to have Rev. Aric Fenske (and his wife Marie) on January 11. He preached at both services on Sunday and did the Adult Bible class. It was truly a blessing to have him preach and teach about being a Gospel motivated voice for life. Our church had a free will offering on January 11 for LFL.
